


A Cleaning Schedule

From the 1924 Rumford Book on Home Management

- 1. Dust bric-a-brac and clean metals. Place them all together and cover them up
- Dust wood furniture and vacuum-clean overstuffed furniture. Remove the smaller pieces to another room if possible. Cover those which remain. In bedroom take off bedding and thoroughly clean spring and mattress, make up again and cover.
- 3. Clean rugs with a vacuum cleaner and roll them up
- Remove portieres and draperies and clean them no a flat surface with a vacuum cleaner
- 5. Dust ceiling and walls
- 6. Dust wood trim, doors and surbase
- 7. Clean windows and mirrors
- 8. Dust pictures
- 9. Dust lighting fixtures, wash globes
- 10. Clean and polish floors
- 11. Replace everything
