History matters – the trail you followed in the past is a good indication of where you are headed in the future.

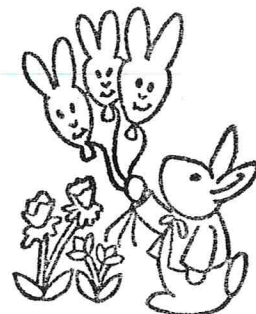

It is a free event with music at noon with Clark Speck.

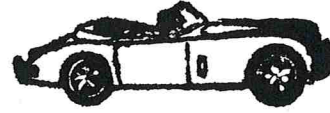
