Karen Kaminsky and her husband, Peter, presented her great uncle's WWII uniform to the museum at our meeting on behalf of her mother, Ruth Milewski. The uniform was worn by Ruth's brother, Roman Milewski. Roman was killed in action in Belgium in WWII. He was 33 years old, leaving behind a wife and young daughter, Mary Ellen and Milewski family members. The Milewski's owned a tavern on 9th and Milwaukee Ave. and lived above the tavern. Items donated include a Bronze Star, received in December, 1944, Purple Heart, Burial Flag used in Belgium, a life sized pencil sketch of Roman by J Schultz, done in 1965. The portrait served as a model for the Mural on the brick wall of the AmVets building in South Milwaukee done by Todd Rosinski – Mural Makers of Milwaukee, 1997. Also included are letters and articles about the family and his burial site in Belgium. We honor Roman Milewski and all the veterans who gave everything.

Ancient Recipe for Roman Custard made by Marcus G

Tiberius(14 – 37 C.E.)

ukee, WI 53172

2 cups milk

3 egg yolks ¹/₄ tsp nutmeg

1/4 cup honey

berries for garnish (I used almond milk and the whole eggs. I baked it 30 minutes.)

Whisk eggs in bowl. Mix milk and honey in a saucepan and heat briefly. Remove from heat and add well beaten eggs. Add nutmeg, stir. Pour into a baking dish and bake in 325 degree oven for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove and let set for 1 hour.

The History Mystery

I am always learning something new. Two weeks ago I learned there were 10 pyramids under water in Rock Lake next to Lake Mills, WI. near Aztalan. The outer layer of sea shells and limestone on the pyramids has been carbon dated to 1250 BC, I have been told. It causes more questions.

Ancient copper mines in upper Michigan have been carbon dated to this time also. In September, Steve and I went to upper Michigan to see one of these mines. We were very fortunate to meet Matt the owner of the Adventure Mine, who showed us 2 early sites that have not been destroyed by development. He said the water level then was 500 to 600 feet higher in Lake Superior than it is now. He said someone was making a movie/ video for TV on underground mysteries to be on TV in late fall this year. They filmed at the Adventure Mine also.

Some people think there is a connection between these two sites. More to learn...
