| Files of scanned newspapers from 1921 to 1943 I have been received from the Wisconsin State I Historical Society Microfilm Lab and are being prepared to be added to the existing online newspapers. We expect this to be completed by April 30, 2023. The remaining scans (1944 to 2006) are on schedule and should be online this summer. At that time the entire run of the South Milwaukee newspaper will be accessible online and searchable by key word. Thanks to all those who donated to this joint Historical Society and South Milwaukee Library project and to the Society and Library representatives who have worked to make this project successful.
